Oxford – The Oxford Historical Society is continuing its sale of inscribed commemorative brick paving stones. The bricks will be laid at the Twitchell-Rowland Homestead Museum at 60 Towner Lane. Bricks are available for two prices. The \$60 bricks are laid in the walkway to the entrance of the Homestead. The \$40 bricks surround the small garden on the back lawn of the Homestead, or will be placed in future garden walkways planned for the Museum property. Text can be up to three lines of 20 characters each. The laser-generated inscription is printed in permanent black lettering guaranteed to last a century. All donations are tax deductible.
